If locals in Cheam are looking for something just a bit special in Indian food, then they are unlikely to do better than this new opening. Decked in a strikingly modern interior yet warm and intimate at the same time, where Samsara takes a more winning approach than any high street counterpart is in its contemporary cooking. To start, there is crab cake with ginger and chilli flakes, Jaipuri whitebait and lamb jhankar, scallop of lamb stuffed with pickled mango. House specials include spiced monkfish in a coconut and tomato sauce, railway lamb with potatoes and curry leaves, along with grilled sea bass with crispy spinach, red chilli and ground spices. There are also a number of the "usual suspect" dishes such as the Madras and vindaloo, all competently rendered.
